Our residential recovery program offers at-risk girls the opportunity to live, learn and heal within a structured and supportive environment where they can experience the unconditional love of God and the transforming power of the Gospel. This isn't drug rehab, this is learning a new life, free from drugs and alcohol, giving the girls a new sense of purpose and direction for their lives.

We are staffed by a team of compassionate, Christian leaders who are specially trained and dedicated to working with troubled girls, ages 12 to 17, who are in danger of making decisions that will have lifelong destructive consequences for themselves and their families. It is our goal to guide young girls toward discovering their true identity in Christ and fulfilling their God-given destiny and purpose.

Our home and school, both parts of this Tooele Utah rehabilitation facility, are located on a quiet, five-acre property in rural Utah that includes an apple orchard; cherry, apricot, walnut, and peach trees, chickens, horses, pigs, ducks and a large greenhouse.
