Approximately 60% of our clients are single mothers and many receive public assistance. Our program impacts over 2,500 individuals annually, including the children of our clients.

For nearly 2 decades, The Sharing Place has been fulfilling its mission to "provide a safe and caring environment for grieving children, teens, and their families to share their feelings while healing themselves."

The Sharing Place now hosts fourteen age-appropriate grief support groups for children ages 3-18. The parents meet separately in groups designed to meet their needs. Each group is led by a coordinator and a number of volunteers who have all completed extensive training. Our coordinators and the support group volunteers are the heart and soul of our program.
