PAUL T. MOXLEY

Paul T. Moxley is a shareholder with the law firm Cohne Kinghorn, P.C. Following law school, Paul was a law clerk to David T. Lewis who was Chief Judge of the Tenth Circuit for the United States circuit Court. Paul Moxley was "Distinguished Lawyer of the Year" by the Utah State Bar for 2009-2010. Paul Moxley is rated "AV Preeminent" by Martindale Hubble, which is the highest rating awarded to attorneys for professional competence and ethics. He is a past President of the Utah State Bar and the National Conference of Bar Presidents, and he has served in the House of Delegates of the American Bar Association. In 2015, the Utah State Bar recognized Mr. Moxley by naming a mentoring award after him. He was on the Board of Governors of the ABA representing four western states from 2012-2015. He is a past Chancellor of the Jackrabbit Bar Association, a group of eight State Bars from UT, WY, ID, MT, NV, NM, ND and SD. He is State Chair of the Utah Fellows of the American Bar Association, a group consisting of less than one-third of one percent of elite UT lawyers. Mr. Moxley has been listed in Best Lawyers in American (commercial litigation) and has been recognized frequently among Utah's "Legal Elite" according to Utah Business Magazine. Mr. Moxley was a member of the ABA Standing Committee of the federal judiciary for a term of three years, where he vetted potential federal judges. He will be chairman of this committee for 2018 through 2019 directing the work of the fourteen-person committee. He served as commissioner for the Utah Judicial Conduct Commission and is a past member of the ABA Standing Committee on Judicial Independence. Paul was a member

of the Alta Town Council from '02 through '18.
