WORLD BANK AND ROTARY INTERNATIONAL CELEBRATE INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

Three women were recognized on March 7 at the World Bank in Washington, DC for their commitment to improving lives through innovative humanitarian projects.

The celebration, hosted by the World Bank Group Staff Association, and sponsored by Rotary International and investment firm Oppenheimer & Company was one of many events held to mark International Women's Day each year. Annette Dixon, Vice President of the World Bank for South Asia, moderated the event.

Speaking to more than 300 people, with thousands watching the livestream, Dr. Geetha Jayaram, Marie-Irene Richmond Ahoua, and Danielle De La Fuente, all Rotarians explained how their work helped poor women in India gain access to mental health care, vaccinate hundreds of thousands against polio in West Africa, and empower refugee children around the world.

"These are women of action who are making a huge contribution to the world," Dixon said. "They have given so much of themselves to their initiatives and are playing a leadership role for many women."
