

Bear-O Care Support for Individuals with Multiple Disabilities and their Families

Bear-O Care was founded to help care for individuals with multiple disabilities who are often turned away from other facilities because of their physical disabilities. They are designed to serve those with a combination of the following:

- Deaf/blindness
- Acute/Traumatic Brain Injury
- Cerebral Palsy
- Retts Syndrome
- Angelmans Syndrome
- CHARGE Syndrome
- Gastric Tube Feedings
- Incontinent/Diapered
- Total dependence on others for ADL
- Wheelchair dependent

There are more than 200,000 families according to disabilityplanningdata.com—with disabilities in Utah, many of which—because of the severity of their condition and the amount of care they need—are not able to receive the full benefits of the government sponsored programs, like Medicaid, laid out to help them. That is where Bear-O Care stepped in. The nonprofit organization aims to fill the gap in the system where these families are not able to receive the care and support they need.

Frank McNiece, who has been part of the South Valley Rotary Club for the past 36 years, is trying to expand organizations like this to areas out of Utah. "It started here, and it's the only place where it's being done," McNiece said. McNiece and his wife, Mary-Lou, have been generous donors to the Bear-O Care nonprofit. Mary-Lou hand sewed and gifted a "Teddy" Bear-O Care to each of the patients currently enrolled. Frank said they are trying to raise money and awareness so they can spread this service to other locations. Frank joined Rotary in 1981. Both he and his wife are Paul Harris Fellows. He received his BS in Business Administration from Westminster College, is a Vietnam veteran and served in the Navy from 1965 to 1969. CALENDAR
