A godsend to women and children fleeing homelessness, domestic violence or human trafficking.

In Los Angeles each night, there are 58,000 homeless people but just 13,000 beds to serve them. Of those many thousands of homeless, more than 1/4 are desperate women and children sleeping on the streets, in cars or on couches or in garages of family or friends.

19 years ago Judy, a feminist and political activist often at odds with the Catholic Church, started the Alexandria House, with Church resources, to help as many people in need as she could. Today at the Alexandria House, women of diverse backgrounds live together with their children, safe and sheltered from the horrors that sent them there, as they strive to build new productive and loving lives for themselves.

The Alexandria provides transitional housing for up to two years, and vital services such as childcare, counseling, financial guidance and job training, family skills, along with access to healthcare and legal assistance. But none of this would exist without Judy, who for 50 years despite living her vow of poverty has continued to raise the resources to make so many wonderful things possible for others.
