# SUGAR HOUSE COMMUNITY COUNCIL Landon Clark

After serving as the Dilworth trustee for over a year, the Sugar House Community Council (SHCC) appointed Landon Clark as the new council chair in October. Clark has spent the majority of his life in SLC and graduated from the University of Utah; he and his wife spent only a few years away in Rochester, MN to attend school. The Clarks returned to Utah where they settled in Sugar House 14 years ago and consider themselves Sugar House "Lifers". Clark learned of the Dilworth trustee spot a year and a half ago during a community council meeting at his children's school. He was immediately interested and thinks it is very important to take an active role in your community. In addition to sitting on the SHCC. Clark is the Chair of the **Dilworth Elementary School Community** Council.

"The influx of people into Sugar House brings some headaches, like traffic and parking, but the restaurant options, new businesses, and bustling downtown are really cool. I like walking up 2100 S and seeing all the restaurants busy on a weekday night," Clark said.

On average, the council reviews two to three building proposals a month. In October the Land, Use, and Zoning (LUZ) sub-committee of SHCC approved the Dixon Medical Office and Marriott Springhill Suites Hotel. In November, LUZ reviewed the 21st Master Plan, as well as Harmons's seeking approval for a fuel center at their Brickyard location.
