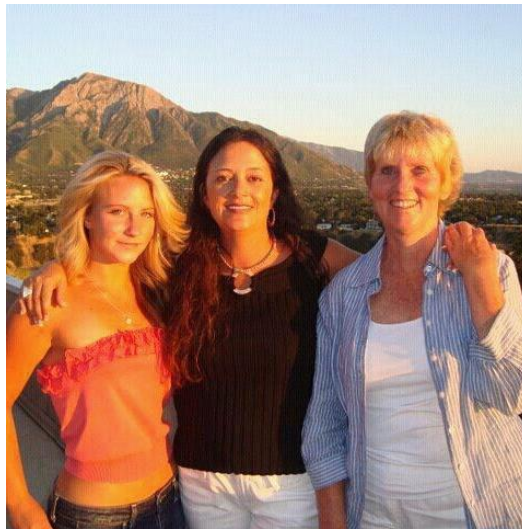
Oh, beautiful for spacious skies,
