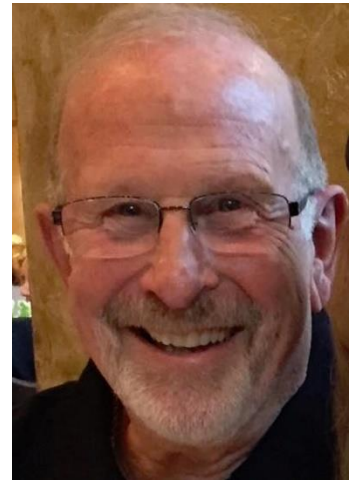
**Barry R. Bank**
